#### Art and DT: Active Learners Confidence



### Maths: Confidence, Resilience, Active Leaners

We will be starting the final half term with more work on statistics. Following from last half term, we will begin with a revision of line graphs before moving on to bar graphs and pie charts. We will then revise calculating the mean. We will finish the year with algebra, starting off with function machines and learning then to describe rules and patterns. Daily fluency sessions will continue with a focus on key skills for high school.

## Science: Active Learners Knowledge Forest School

Continuing our work on lifecycles, this half term we will be focussing on animals. We will begin with mammals and link this to revisiting our work on puberty before high school. We will then look a variety of animal groups and their lifecycles. Throughout the term we will be using a variety of scientific skills to observe changes in animals, record carefully sets of data we collect and work to conclude our experiments.
