



Atlantis Class Meet The Teacher Evening

Science:



Around the world



- Our first half term theme is Around the World.
- This theme focuses different countries, continents, climates and animals around the world. In English look at fiction stories by author Rachel Bright. As well as writing non-fiction pieces on animals.
- This topic is heavily Geography based but our History comes by looking at how countries have changed and through out theme weeks.

P.E., Homework and Reading



- Our P.E days are Monday and Tuesday. Children will need to come to school in kit on these days. We do ask that children have PE pumps in their lockers for indoor PE.
- Spellings are set on a Monday, to be tested the following Monday. This year the homework consists of:
- Year 1 Spellings, Reading, Numbots

- Children will be heard read throughout the week.


Spellings

- Spelling quizzes are on a Monday.
- Strategies for you to help your child:
- Use shaving foam, write in sand, write in the air (multisensory)
- Use magnetic letters
- Use fancy pens
- Have fun!

Phonics for Year 1


- Year 1 follow Red Rose for their phonics.
- We have phonics daily and the children will take part in the phonics screen in June. The screen consists of real and 'alien' words designed to test the children's knowledge of the sounds they have learnt in phonics.

Year 1: Numbots

- The children all have a Numbots login, sent via Dojo.
- Little and often is the key to success.
- The games help to secure key skills such as subitising, early addition, one more/less etc
- This is a smart game so it helps children practise areas they need more work on







Year 2: Times Table Rock Stars

- Times Table Rock Stars is a homework computer game.
- This is for children to have a go and begin to start practising their times tables.
- The games are timed but there are no expectations for the children to achieve a set amount of correct answers in the time of the game.
- Like Numbots, it is a smart game. This means it will set games in relations to the times tables we set for them to learn and the answers they repeatedly get incorrect.



















Class Dojo and Website
