Maths:

In maths this half term we will continue with daily fluency sessions as part of our morning routine.

In maths lessons the children will continue with the unit on addition and subtraction. We will continue to spot links, find effective strategies and reason. We will then lead into multiplication and division and finish with some work on measures.

The children will become confident, fluent mathematicians who are able to tackle problems with resilience.

PSHE

In PHSE this half term the children will look at how their bodies change as they grow. We will continue to celebrate our differences and talk about ways in which we respect ourselves and others.



Geography/History:

This half term we will remember the brave soldiers who fought for us during World War 2. This special week will be dedicated to learning about what life was like during the Blitz.





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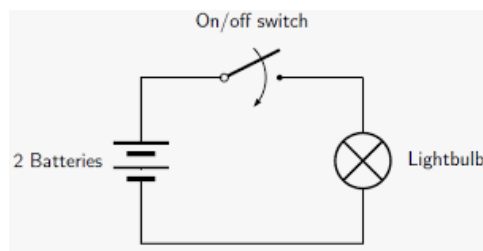
P.E: Confidence, courageous, partnerships

In our PE units this half term, the children will have to show great **confidence** and **courage**. The children will continue to work on their **sportsmanship**, **listening** and **perseverance** within every PE lesson. We will be covering hockey and gymnastics each week as our focus sports, and will continue to reinforce the importance of team work in all aspects of PE and sport.

Art/DT:

This half term, we will create some art work linked to our World War 2 themed week. The children will use some skills from last half term and blend charcoal, graphite sticks and chalks to create a soldier scene.

As part of our DT unit, we will plan design and make a torch with a bulb that lights up. This unit will link heavily to our science unit where the children will be learning about electricity.



Science: Active learners/partnerships

This half term are becoming super scientists as we delve into the world of electricity! The children will identify common appliances that run on electricity and talk about what it might be like to live without electricity. Pupils will learn about the symbols used when making a circuit and work collaboratively when making a circuit that can light a bulb, motor or buzzer. The children will work scientifically by observing patterns, for example, bulbs get brighter if more cells are added.

IT: Meaningful progression of skills

In Computing, we will continue to build on the work that has been previously taught with programming. Children will be introduced to new software as well as looking at Scratch. We will plan, implement and evaluate our programming.
